# a. Character Education/Citizenship

- i. There is a new state initiative called Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS).
  - 1. School Survey How do we determine satisfaction for what we do as a school?
    - a. DPI lumps everything into one survey called "school climate"
    - b. Deerfield surveys in different ways (website survey, communication survey, etc.)

## c. Key Ideas:

## i. The Survey's Purpose

- 1. To gather first hand (primary source) information
- 2. To get feedback on specific topics
- 3. To identify our strengths and needs as a district
- 4. a 360 degree evaluation asking all people involved
  - a. Parents, students, staff
- 5. To gather baseline data for future survey and evaluation
- 6. To gain fresh, new ideas
- 7. To provide an opportunity for all to voice their thoughts

# ii. Who Should Be Surveyed?

- 1. Students at the elementary, middle, and high school levels
- 2. Staff both teaching and support staff
- 3. Parents one survey per child at each building

## iii. What Should We Do With The Information?

- 1. Who Will Look At It?
  - a. Information should be available to all
- 2. How Will It Be Made Available?
  - a. Internal report first
    - i. Viewed by DISC
    - ii. Viewed by staff and discussed at meetings
  - b. External Summary
    - i. Board Report
    - ii. Results available on school website

#### iv. How Should We Survey?

- 1. Which will get a bigger response paper or computer?
  - a. Can we send the survey home with students?
    - i. Elementary will more than likely return it
    - ii. Middle school and high school may not have a good response rate.
    - iii. Should we offer a website option?

## v. What Do We Want To Know?

- 1. How do we keep it general (manageable), but still allow people to express ideas?
- 2. What topics should be surveyed? Possibilities:
  - a. Physical appearance of the building
  - b. Atmosphere welcoming or not?
  - c. Bullying and harassment
  - d. Technology 21<sup>st</sup> century and accessability
  - e. Are classroom environments conducive to learning?
  - f. Is the school environment conducive to learning?
  - g. Are our academics challenging?
  - h. School pride
  - i. Athletic Facilities
  - i. Character Education
  - k. School Board
  - 1. Administration
  - m. Food Program
  - n. Opportunities and Bridges
  - o. Communication
  - p. Relationships
