1. Staff Presentation: Kirsten Wohlers demonstrated how she uses the Smartboard Technology to educate and engage High School students in Geometry, Algebra and Advanced Math classes. She showed the group a typical daily lesson plan that included: daily overview with goals, homework quiz review, moving and rotating shapes, using bright and consistent colors, printing note pages and documenting teacher's comments for later review. She reviewed a Smartboard survey that her students had completed: 100% of the students preferred to use the Smartboard as part of their math education. The students thought that their learning has increased mainly due to the use of readable text, printable notes, examples and diagrams on the Smartboard.
