Executive Summary

Every five years since 1980, Dane County youth in grades 7-12 have been surveyed regarding their opinions, concerns, attitudes, behaviors and experiences to provide educators, service providers, parents, policy-makers and funding bodies accurate and current data to inform grant writing, program development and public policy. The following assessment was conducted at a four year interval. Moving forward, a two or three year administration cycle will be used to keep pace with the rate of change within our community.

The Youth Assessment is a collaborative effort led by the Dane County Youth Commission in partnership with the United Way of Dane County, Public Health of Madison & Dane County, and fourteen Dane County school districts. The 2009 survey was administered electronically through middle and high schools on a voluntary and anonymous basis. The conversion from a paper and pencil format to an electronic one increased survey reliability and provided immediate results and useable data. Youth overwhelmingly preferred the electronic format feeling it was more private and easier to take.

Planning Process

The Youth Assessment planning process began in November 2007 with the creation of a Steering Committee chaired by Youth Commission member Gale Garvey and charged with overseeing all phases of planning, designing and implementing the project. The Commission contracted with Brian Koenig (K12 Associates) to administer the project including participation in survey development, converting the survey to an electronic format, coordinating with school districts to ensure successful survey administration, data analysis and report writing including this document.

Development of survey content and questions included input from many sources. In January 2008, stakeholders throughout the community were invited to review the 2005 survey instrument and suggest changes. Dane County Youth Board members reviewed the survey providing valuable input on language and encouraging the committee to be direct and specific with questions. Pupil Services staff from all participating Dane County school districts reviewed every draft of the survey providing input on the issues regularly encountered in their buildings. Members of the Steering Committee brought expertise in areas of public and physical health, education, school issues, psychometrics, epidemiology, youth protective and risk factors and community trends. As many of the Committee members are parents, this perspective was represented as well. Consultation outside of the Committee was sought on questions related to substance abuse, sexual activity and mental health. State and national youth survey questions were added to allow Dane County youth trends to be compared to state and national youth trends. Throughout the planning process, the Committee and school partners critically reviewed the survey instrument to ensure that it continued to address issues of importance to Dane County

Youth. Questions were retained, modified or added to reflect emerging trends and interests resulting in a final survey that was approved by all involved. Survey topics include family, peer, community and school experiences, involvement in activities, youth assets, health and nutrition and engagement in risk behaviors such as alcohol/drug use and sexual activity.

Administration

Survey administration successfully took place from November 2008 to early February 2009. The electronic format allowed districts to survey youth over a period of time thereby capturing those who may have been absent, suspended, or missing school for other reasons on a given day. The 2008 survey includes youth who attend regular and alternative district programs. Due to its size, the Madison Metropolitan School District used a sampling process rather than attempting to survey all students (census.) The data for MMSD has been weighted in this report to be consistent with the other districts that used a census to survey most every student. Therefore, the “N” or “Number” of students surveyed that is used in this report reflects the weighted MMSD sampling plus the total number of students who completed the survey in the other districts.

Data Use

This report summarizes student response frequencies for the 117 survey items by grade level. It does not offer any other type of analysis or draw conclusions from the data. The Youth Commission and Steering Committee is committed to maximizing the use and potential of this data base and will encourage more in depth analysis throughout 2009 by the various funding partners, academic entities and by the Steering Committee.

Conclusion

The 2008-2009 Youth Assessment marks the sixth time the Youth Commission has coordinated an opportunity for 7th-12th grade youth in Dane County to voice their opinions, needs, concerns, interests and aspirations. This effort provides the community with information and insight on youth trends over a twenty-year period. Although not the only source of information on what is impacting youth in our community, the Youth Assessment provides one very valuable resource to inform program and policy decisions. The data reflected in this report is encouraging in some areas and challenging in others. The Youth Commission and its partners hope that youth-serving agencies, community stakeholders, parents, policy makers, school districts and youth will use this and subsequent reports to appreciate where we have been, to recognize the successes and challenges of today and to create an even brighter future for Dane County.
