## **2009 Version of DCYA**

- Twenty-nine years of data now collected
- Over 24,000 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders surveyed in 2008-2009
- Fourteen participating Dane Co. school districts



## Changing Student Population

- In 2004, the Dane County public school HS enrollment had increased by 26% since 1995 (versus 9% statewide)\*
- Deerfield HS increased by 22% (41 students) in the same period
- MS enrollment is up 15% county-wide
  Deerfield MS enrollment is up 14%

### **Diversity Topics** Deerfield Students


Fifteen percent of HS students and 30% MS students in 2005 say they <u>could not</u> be friends with someone gay/lesbian

Twenty-five percent of HS kids and 30% of the MS students say they would not like to learn more about other races/ethnic groups

### Deerfield Students Self-reported GPA

- In 2005, 73% of HS girls say they are getting 3.5+ compared to 56% of boys.
- In 1995, it was girls 46%, boys 28%
- In MS 2005, it's 71% for girls and 56% for boys.

#### Middle Schooler Activities Deerfield 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Graders

- Thirteen percent of 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders are using the internet more than 10 hours per week.
- Eighteen percent use electronic games for more than 10 hours.
- Seventy-two percent are playing cards or gambling each week. (13% more than HS kids)
- Fifty-eight percent spend 5+ hours/week on sports


### Fewer Dane Co. H.S. Students Exercising Regularly



- In Dane Co. about 29% exercise 5X per week or more (down from 35% in '00)
- More than 56% of Deerfield HS kids exercise 5x or more
- 60% of Deerfield MS kids say they exercise 5X+per week
- 12% of U.S. HS students get no exercise each week (8% in Deerfield)

## Other HS Alcohol Trends Are Static


- County wide binge drinking in the last month up for students with any beer/wine use in the past year (49% in '00 and 54% in '05)
- In Deerfield 51% of this same group were binge drinkers
- Seventy percent of Deerfield HS kids who drink beer/wine monthly are binge drinkers.
- About 12% of Dane County students in 2000 and 2005 drink and drive compared to on only 6% and 8% respectively for Deerfield students.

# Middle Schoolers Drug/Alcohol Use

- 15% have had beer or wine in the last year
  4% tried hard liquor
- Only 1% say they've tried marijuana
- OTC drugs next in popularity to alcohol more than marijuana – at 7%
- More than 5% have been binge drinking 1x.
- Twenty-three percent have ridden with an adult who's been drinking

#### First Time in 15 Years Marijuana Use at Least Once in 12 Months by HS Students




## Marijuana Use Trends Mixed

- CDC\* data shows 23% of U.S. High Schoolers using marijuana monthly (versus 18% in Dane Co and 12% in Deerfield)
- Of students using marijuana in the past year <u>daily</u> use is up (10% in '00 to 16% in '05) in Dane County.
- For Deerfield HS kids that use marijuana daily use is also up (10% in '00 to 13% in '05)
- More Deerfield HS students ride with friends under the influence of marijuana (14%) than under the influence of alcohol (12%)

(9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade Students)


On Averge, Have At Least One Smoke per Day





% of Students Having at Least 1 Conversation w/ Parents About Drugs/Drinking



#### Parent Values Make a Difference in Teen Behavior



- At a national level 47% of high schoolers report having sex at least 1x (37% statewide)\*
- For 90% of Dane Co. teens who have had intercourse, the 1st time is before age 17

### Mental Health Issues

- For County HS students, thoughts-of-suicide percentages static for 15 years (around 18%).
- Thoughts of suicide among Deerfield HS students is up – 13% in '00 to 18' in '05.
- Deerfield MS students with thoughts of suicide in 2005 is up slightly (11% '00 to 13% '05)
- County HS students with thoughts of suicide have lower grades, are more sexually active and worry more about their appearance.
