Deerfield Academic Decathlon Team Advances to Regional Competition

On Tuesday, November 9, 2010, the Deerfield Academic Decathlon Team participated in the Local Round of the 2010-2011 Academic Decathlon Competition. The 20 students representing Deerfield High School took tests in Art, Music, Economics, Math, Language & Literature, and Social Science. All of these test

centered around this year's theme which is "The Great Depression."

On Friday, November 12th, Deerfield's Academic Decathlon coach, Gerald Wichlacz was notified that the team qualified for Regional Competition. One hundred and twenty-six teams took the Local test and only sixty schools advance to Regional Competition.

The team's next competition will be a practice competition held on Tuesday, November 30th, after school. Results from this competition will be combined with the Local test results to help determine the makeup of our nine person competition team that will be participating at Regionals. Each high school team consists of nine full-time students, 9th through 12th grade, and is made up of three Honor students (3.75-4.00 GPA), three students in the Scholastic (3.00-3.74 GPA) and three in the Varsity (0.00-2.99 GPA) category. All nine students write all the tests and the top two scores in each category determine the team score. In this way, the program offers the appeal of mental competition at all achievement levels.

The team will be writing an essay on Dec. 7 as part of the competition and then will be traveling to either U.W. - Whitewater or Stevens Point on January 7, 2011 to write their six tests and give their speeches and interviews. Hopefully, Deerfield will score high enough to be among the 20 teams that will advance to the State Competition in Wisconsin Dells on March 17-18, 2011.

Bullying Awareness

Parents, if you are aware of bullying and harassment occurring at school, would you please inform your child's homeroom teacher.
