Update on Current Issues

A. Crossing on Liberty to Savannah Oaks Park

- Citizens concerned that students are not watching for vehicles when crossing Liberty St.
- Discussed posting signs at end of school sidewalk and in traffic median
- Michelle Jensen will talk with Mark Becker about cautioning students and parents

B. School Signage

- Discussed need for street signs indicating village buildings such as school, library. Village board is exploring this topic as well.
- Discussed school zone signs for township and village roads.

C. Well-site Update

- Village secured federal stimulus money and a low-interest loan to cover well development.

D. Savannah Oaks Development

- Four lots have been sold at this time

E. BID Money-Village

- This money is earmarked for use to beautify the downtown-signs, banners, garbage receptacles are potential purchases being discussed by Village board.

F. Historical Society-Upper Village Hall

- Historical society is open for public.
- Michelle Jensen will forward this information to 4th grade teachers for Wisconsin history unit.

G. Bus Transportation within Village

- District will be holding a special meeting on Dec. 21 to discuss option of providing bus transportation for students living in village and 1 mile or greater from school.
- Parameters for changing the current policy included minimal addition to bus time, minimal cost increase.

H. US Cellular Calling All Communities \$100,000

- School has entered contest to win a chance at this money. Community needs to vote online.

- Greg Frutiger, Diane Wilkinson, Heather Smith seats are up for election. Some intend to run again.
